Duty to cooperate

- UN Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), Arts. 61, 118 and 197
- Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), Art. 5
- UN Fish Stocks Agreement (UNFSA), Art. 8
- 1992 Rio Declaration, Principle 7



Duty to prevent harm

- UNCLOS, Art. 194.2
- CBD, Art. 3
- 1992 Rio Declaration, Principle 2

Duty to protect the marine environment

Duty to conserve marine living resources



Regional Seas Programmes






- Mostly coastal areas

Regional Fisheries Management Organisations (RFMOs) - Tuna



Regional Fisheries Management Organisations (RFMOs) — Non-Tuna








Regional Organisations Southeast Pacific






Tuna RFMO: IATTC


Conservation and Management Tools









Regional Organisations within a New International Agreement on ABNJ



What role will regional organisations play in a new international instrument on ABNJ?:

- No simple answer
- Depends on each element of the new agreement:
 - Environmental impact assessments and strategic environmental assessments
 - Fair and equitable access to and sharing of the benefits from marine genetic resources
 - Capacity-building and technology transfer
 - Global framework for ABMT, incl. establishment of MPAs
